LEARN CHORAL TECHNIQUES FROM PAUL SPICER

Paul is a composer, conductor and musicologist and one of the leading exponents in British music today. He sees this day, the Choir's fourth singing event at CHS, as a friendly and informal opportunity to impart tips on singing and choral techniques as found in two contrasting works from different periods.

THE WHITEHALL CHOIR is a friendly and ambitious choir which gives three major concerts a year – the next is Haydn's *Paukenmesse* and Weber's *Mass in E Flat* on 3 July 2010, at St John's Smith Square, SW1. It has made two CDs under Paul Spicer's direction – Bruckner's *Mass in E Minor* and Spicer's *Deciduous Cross* and, in 2009, *Fairest flower of any field*, hailed by *Gramophone* magazine as a Christmas must-buy.
