## PAUL SPICER

Paul began his musical training as a chorister at New College, Oxford. He studied with Herbert Howells and Richard Popplewell (organ) at the Royal College of Music in London, winning the Walford Davies Organ Prize in his final year. This is Paul's 11th season with the Whitehall Choir; he also conducts the Birmingham Bach Choir and the chamber choirs at the Birmingham Conservatoire where, in addition to Oxford University, he teaches choral conducting. He founded the Finzi Singers in 1984 with whom he made 15 CDs for Chandos. Paul is in great demand, too, as a recording producer and as a composer. He has just finished a major biography and study of works of Sir George Dyson and is about to begin a commission for a choral symphony commemorating the centenary of the outbreak of the First World War in 2014. The longfordbrown piano duo was formed in 2002 when James Longford and Lindy Tennent-Brown met as Junior Fellows at the Royal College of Music. They are laureates of several major international competitions, winning Third Prize in the 14th International Schubert Competition in the Czech Republic in 2005, Second Prize and the Rachmaninov Award in the 2007 IBLA Grand Prize in Sicily and, most recently, performing as semi-finalists in the Murray Dranoff International Two-Piano Competition in Miami, Florida – placing them in the top five piano duos worldwide.
