Joanna Tomlinson, the music director of Whitehall Choir, is also the Music Director of the internationally renowned Farnham Youth Choirs, and of Constanza Chorus. She has worked with BBC Symphony Chorus, National Youth Choirs of Great Britain, and Royal College of Music Chorus. In demand as a workshop leader, Joanna's recent engagements include UK Choir Festival, Association of British Choral Directors, and the Gabrieli Consort 'Roar' education scheme. She is currently Chorus Master for Glyndebourne and Brighton Festival's major new community project.

Pianist and organist **Ian Tindale**, accompanist of Whitehall Choir, studied at Cambridge and the Royal College of Music. In 2017 he was awarded the Pianist's Prize at the Wigmore Hall/Kohn Foundation Song Competition. Recent engagements have included song recitals across Europe and the UK, including performances at the Leeds Lieder and Ryedale Festivals, and he frequently appears as a member of the London Philharmonic Orchestra.
